Work on the town park bathrooms is progressing by contractor, Ron Briggs. Also, looking into replacing the boiler at the Town Hall. Funds to cover these costs are from ARP funds.

Salt Shed project, staging of equipment has begun by awarded contractor, Keller Construction. Awarded bid amount is \$1,294,488.

Kerry Foster contacted Supervisor Mowers about opening the gate off of Fairview road. He stated that the club would be putting cameras up to spot any type of violators if given permission. On a MOTION to allow for the gate to be opened by Nora Cool-Guinup and seconded by Colleen Walrath it was approved ayes all.

Whitestone Academy – the courts have ruled against the town and the town will be required to make restitution to them as a tax refund with interest as follows: Town- \$13,627.38 and fire dist. - \$7,907.40.
